

A BY-LAW

TO FURTHER AMEND BY-LAW 1313 OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA ENTITLED "HIRED VEHICLES AMENDMENT BY-LAW 1912" AS ALREADY AMENDED.

The Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Victoria enacts as follows:—

- 1. Section 2 of By-law No. 1313 of the City of Victoria entitled "Hired Vehicles Amendment By-law, 1912," as amended by By-law No. 1390, By-law No. 1461 and By-law No. 1504, is hereby repealed and the following is hereto enacted instead and in lieu thereof:—
- "(2) No person shall act as driver for any such vehicle as aforesaid without first obtaining from the Chief of Police a license in the form 'B' hereunto annexed, and a numbered badge which license and badge shall be registered by the Chief of Police, and which badge shall be worn by such driver in a conspicuous position, and a fee shall be paid to the Chief of Police for such license as follows: Two dollars for a first license and two dollars for every renewal thereof. The badge shall be a round solid nickel badge 1¾ inches in diameter and the numbers thereon shall be not less than ¾ of an inch in height and shall be held by a pin affixed in the back thereof and shall be worn on the outside of the lapel of the outer coat and shall contain the words and be in the form of the design thereof which is a schedule to this By-law. The badge shall be supplied by and continue to be the property of the Corporation, and shall be returned to the Chief of Police on expiry or revocation of license; said license shall expire on the thirty-first day of December in the year of such registration."
- "(2a) The fee to be paid as a by a chauffeur of any such vehicle being a motor car or automobile, shall be \$1.00 for a first license and \$1.00 for every renewal thereof."
- 2. Section 8 of said By-law No. 1313 is hereby amended by adding to Subsection (b) thereof the words following:—



"Goods vehicles may stand upon the middle of Blanchard Street between Pandora Avenue and Johnson Street, and between Fort Street and Broughton Street, and on Fisguard Street between Douglas Street and Blanchard Street.

3. This By-law may be cited as "Hired Vehicles Further Amendment By-law, 1913, No. 3."


