BY-LAW NO. 1013

A BY-LAW FOR THE REGULATION OF THE USE OF BICYCLES ON PUBLIC THOROUGHFARES IN THE CITY OF NELSON.

 \mbox{W} H E R E A S $\,$ it is deemed expedient and necessary to regulate the use of bicycles on public thoroughfares in the City of Nelson,

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Nelson in Council assembled enacts as follows:-

- 1. No person shall ride any bicycle upon any sidewalk on any public thoroughfare in the City of Nelson.
- 2. No person shall ride any bicycle on any public thoroughfare in the City of Nelson in any manner in which the rider of such bicycle shall not have absolute control thereof so that he may stop the same immediately or guide it so as to avoid injury or collision.
- 3. No person shall ride any bicycle on any public thoroughfare in the City of Nelson so that by so doing there are thereon more than two bicycles abreast of one another.
- 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride any bicycle without having attached thereto a bell, gong, horn or whistle, in good working order, and sufficient to give plain audible warning of the approach thereof, or to fail or neglect to sound the same when approaching any vehicle, horse or other animal, or pedestrian, or upon approaching any place where any person may be entering or leaving any conveyance, or upon approaching any street intersection, or before passing around any corner.

- 5. An annual tax of fifty cents (50ϕ) is hereby imposed upon each bicycle used in the Municipality of the City of Nelson and such tax shall be due and payable by the owner thereof to the said Corporation on the first day of March in each year at the City Hall in the City of Nelson.
- 6. A license plate shall be attached to each bicycle, which said license plate may be obtained from the City Hall upon payment of the annual tax aforesaid.
- Any person guilty of any infraction of any of the prov-7. isions of this By-Law shall upon conviction before any Magistrate or Justices of the Peace on oath or affirmation of any credible witness forfeit and pay at the discretion of the Magistrate or Justices convicting a penalty not exceeding Five (\$5.00) Dollars for each offence together with the costs of such prosecution, and in default of payment of the said penalty and costs forthwith it shall and may be lawful for the Magistrate or Justices convicting as aforesaid to issue a warrant under his or their hand and seal to levy the said penalty and costs or costs only by distress and sale of the offender's or offenders' goods and chattels and in case of not sufficient distress to satisfy the penalty and costs it shall be lawful for the Magistrate or Justices conmvicting as aforesaid to commit the offender or offenders to the Common Gaol or lock-up house in the City of Nelson for any period not exceeding ten (10) days unless said penalty and costs (if any) including the costs of the said distress and of the committal and conveyance of the offender to the said gaol or lock-up house are sooner paid.

THIS BY-LAW SHALL BE KNOWN AND CITED for all purposes as "CITY OF NELSON BICYCLE REGULATION BY-LAW."

THIS BY-LAW shall come into force and take effect upon the registration thereof.
